# The issue: there is no go-to hoster for internet community projects

- It is not always trivial to find a place to host a service
- Personally paying for hosting for community services is not ideal
- No sustainable hosting: no NOC, one-man shows, what happens 5 years from now?
- No load-balancers, too many apps on 1 server, no isolation
- What about backups?
  
- Example services: IRC, IRRExplorer.nlnog.net, NLNOG RING management servers,

# The solution: NLNOG Infrastructure

- Free hosting for Internet community related projects.
- A group of sysadmin volunteers to manage the operational side
- Global infrastructure – multiple continents
- Automated application deployment, ansible etc
- Focus on long term reliability
